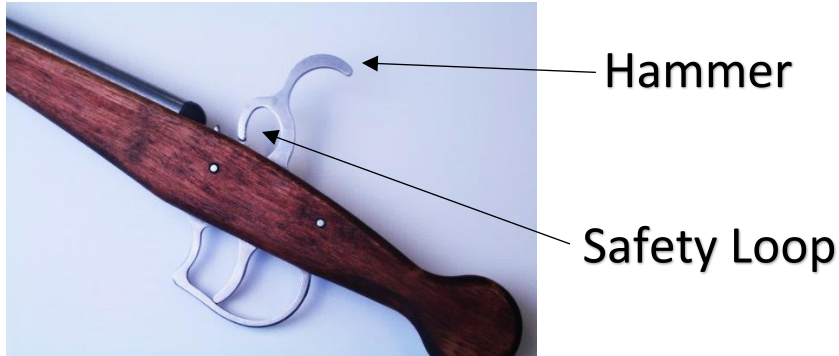


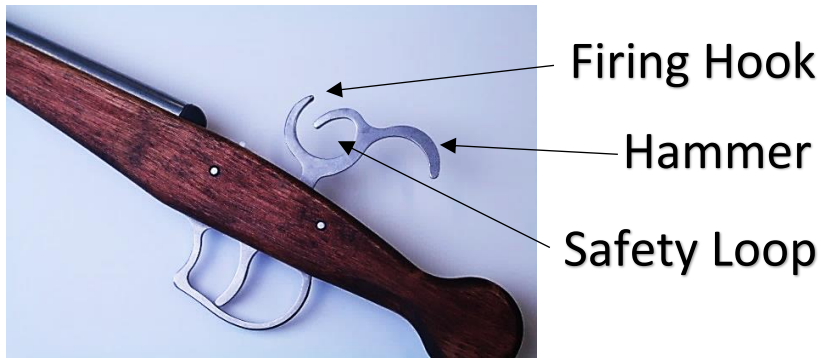
Castille Armory RBG Loading and Firing Instructions

Parts of Your RBG:

When in the “loading” position your pistol will look like this with the hammer forward:



Here it is in the “firing” position:



Loading Your Pistol:

To start, your pistol needs to be in the “loading” position:



If your pistol is NOT in this position pull the trigger and move the hammer forward. Once it's in the correct position, place the taped part of your rubber band in the notch at the end of the barrel and carefully pull the rubber band up the length of the barrel and into the safety loop (we find this is easiest to do if you place the butt of the pistol against your hip/torso and pull the rubber band towards you).

This is the safety position. In this position pulling the trigger does NOT cause the pistol to fire.



Carefully pull back the hammer.

Your pistol now looks like this. This is the firing position. In this position pulling the trigger will cause the pistol to fire.



When you are ready to fire aim and gently squeeze the trigger until the band is released. After firing the pistol, it will return to the "loading" position. This process works on both finger and palm trigger styles.
